

## The Names of Demons and Pagan Deities are Accurately Transliterated in Scripture. Why isn't the Name of the Father? This is Very Inconsistent.

And they forsook YHVH\*, and served **Baal** and **Ashtaroth**. Judges 2:13

And it came to pass, as soon as Gideon was dead, that the children of Israel turned again, and went a whoring after **Baalim**, and made **Baalberith** their god. Judges 8:33

And when they of Ashdod arose early on the morrow, behold, **Dagon** was fallen upon his face to the earth before the ark of YHVH\*. And they took Dagon, and set him in his place again. 1 Samuel 5:3

For Solomon went after **Ashtoreth** the goddess of the Zidonians, and after **Milcom** the abomination of the Ammonites. 1 Kings 11:5

Then did Solomon build an high place for **Chemosh**, the abomination of Moab, in the hill that is before Jerusalem, and for **Molech**, the abomination of the children of Ammon. 1 Kings 11:7

And Ahaziah fell down through a lattice in his upper chamber that was in Samaria, and was sick: and he sent messengers, and said unto them, Go, inquire of **Baalzebub** the god of Ekron whether I shall recover of this disease. 2 Kings 1:2

Declare ye among the nations, and publish, and set up a standard; publish, and conceal not: say, Babylon is taken, **Bel** is confounded, **Merodach** is broken in pieces; her idols are confounded, her images are broken in pieces. Jeremiah 50:2

Then he brought me to the door of the gate of YHVH'S\* house which was toward the north; and, behold, there sat women weeping for **Tammuz**. Ezekiel 8:14

But ye have borne the tabernacle of your **Moloch** and **Chiun** your images, the star of your god, which ye made to yourselves. Amos 5:26

And it came to pass, as he was worshiping in the house of **Nisroch** his god, that Adrammelech and Sharezer his sons smote him with the sword; and they escaped into the land of Armenia... **Isaiah 37:18**

No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve YHVH\* and **mammon**. Matthew 6:24

Yea, ye took up the tabernacle of **Moloch**, and the star of your god **Remphan**, figures which ye made to worship them: and I will carry you away beyond Babylon. Acts 7:43 (quoting Amos 5:26)

And they had a king over them, which is the angel of the bottomless pit, whose name in the Hebrew tongue is **Abaddon**, but in the Greek tongue hath his name **Apollyon**. Revelation 9:11

**This is not an exhaustive list. There are MANY more passages in which pagan names are written.**

\* **NOTE:** Since the translators were not honest with the text, the Father's Name has been accurately returned to its proper place in Scripture according to the original manuscripts. These are but a few of many examples of pagan deities in Scripture. The Father's Name is in Scripture nearly 7,000 times, all of them but one has been removed (**Psalms 68:4**). But even this one witness has been removed from the modern translations (RSV, NIV, Living Bible, New World Translation, NEB, etc.), stolen by the translators.
